



EBID End-of-Year Decoration Mock-up Proposal

Green, gold, and burgundy design concepts for the EBID Headquarters building and visitor-facing interior areas.

Prepared for internal review



Background Note

This redesigned proposal presents a high-resolution set of end-of-year decoration mock-ups for EBID Headquarters. The affected visuals have been rebuilt with clearer backgrounds and decorations integrated directly into each scene rather than hidden behind masks or soft overlays.

The visual direction remains based on the green, gold, and burgundy Heritage Glow palette, tailored to EBID Headquarters and suitable for internal management review.

Proposal Theme

Heritage Glow is the recommended theme. It uses warm architectural lighting, evergreen texture, metallic gold accents, and burgundy floral details to create an elegant end-of-year atmosphere that remains appropriate for a headquarters environment.

Across all areas, the design approach is restrained and practical: frame entrances, enhance existing architectural lines, keep counters and corridors functional, and maintain clear visitor circulation.

Mock-up Image Descriptions

Each image below follows the requested order and shows a high-resolution Heritage Glow treatment for a specific EBID Headquarters area.



Fence

Theme: Perimeter rhythm and gate framing

The fence concept adds green garland swags, warm gold linear lights, and burgundy accents at selected intervals. The treatment carries the theme along the perimeter while preserving security visibility and vehicle movement.



Garden by the Gate

Theme: Low-profile landscape celebration

The garden treatment layers evergreen clusters, gold lanterns, burgundy floral points, and warm garden lighting. It creates a festive first impression without overpowering existing planting, signage, or pedestrian flow.



Pool Area

Theme: Evening water-feature ambience

The pool concept uses warm gold edge lighting, safe floating light points, green garlands, and burgundy floral planters. The decoration is integrated directly onto the pool area while keeping the pool edge clean, safe, and premium.



Pillar near the Stairs

Theme: Formal arrival accent

The stair approach is strengthened with burgundy pillar wraps, warm gold micro-lights, subtle stair lighting, and low evergreen arrangements. The treatment highlights the entrance while keeping the stairs and driveway clear.



Garden

Theme: Low-profile landscape celebration

The garden treatment uses warm gold ground lighting, small evergreen clusters, burgundy ribbon details, and low lantern accents. The decor works with the existing shrubs and road edge without obstructing movement.



Main Entrance

Theme: Formal arrival statement

The entrance is framed with green garlands, gold stair and column lighting, burgundy floral accents, and potted evergreen arrangements. The concept creates a strong first impression while keeping access routes clear.



Reception

Theme: Refined branded welcome desk

The reception counter receives low greenery, gold lighting, and burgundy floral clusters. The decor remains low-profile so the counter stays functional and the existing welcome display remains visible.



Waiting Area

Theme: Photo-call visitor experience

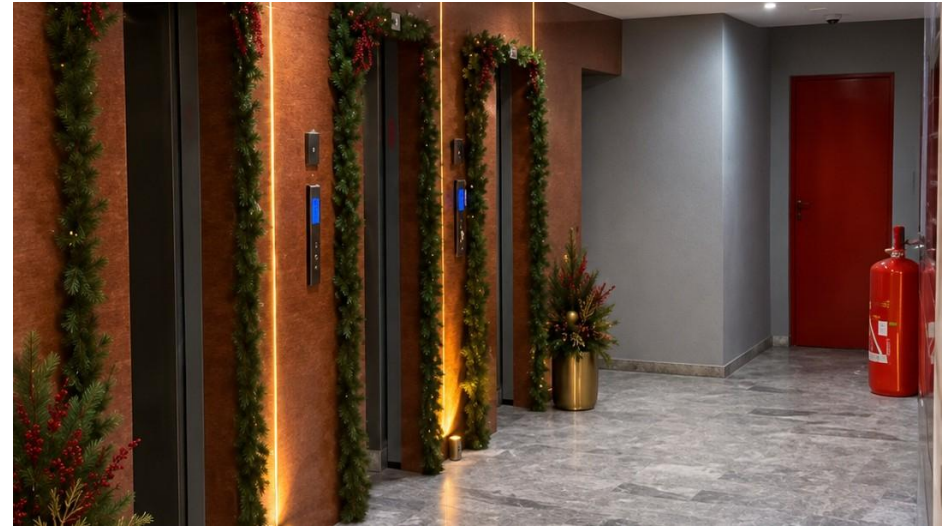
The waiting area is repositioned as a photo-call zone with a greenery backdrop, gold light frame, burgundy floral clusters, and an open standing/photo space. Seating remains usable while creating a stronger visitor-facing moment.



Lobby

Theme: Institutional lobby enhancement with Christmas tree

The lobby introduces a full Christmas tree, ceiling-edge garlands, warm gold lighting, lantern accents, and controlled burgundy florals. The flags, reception desk, and main circulation routes remain open and visible.



Elevator Area

Theme: Vertical indoor accenting

Slim garlands and warm vertical light accents are placed around the elevator zone, supported by low planters and burgundy details. The design keeps elevator access open and avoids clutter in a high-circulation area.

Concluding Note

The redesigned high-resolution mock-up set gives EBID Headquarters a coordinated end-of-year identity across exterior, visitor-facing, and interior circulation areas. The sequence starts with perimeter visibility and arrival impact, then moves through garden, entrance, reception, waiting, lobby, and elevator-zone treatments.

Before implementation, the next recommended step is a site walk-through to confirm dimensions, fixing points, electrical access, safety requirements, pool-safe lighting requirements, and final quantities. Once confirmed, the mock-ups can be translated into a vendor-ready scope of work and cost schedule.

Recommended approval path	Approve the Heritage Glow theme, confirm final decorated zones in the requested order, and request vendor pricing by area.
Primary palette	EBID green, warm gold, and burgundy, supported by warm-white lighting and natural greenery.
Implementation priority	Fence, Garden by the gate, Pool Area, Pillar near the stairs, Garden, Main Entrance, Reception, Waiting Area, Lobby, and Elevator Area.
